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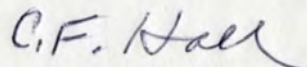

Dear AAAP Member:

The Constitution and By-Laws specify (Article V, Section 3) "Each district shall elect its area board member by the following procedure: The Secretary-Treasurer shall solicit nominations by mail from the voting membership in the district. The three names receiving the greatest number of nominations will appear on the official ballot. This official ballot will be distributed to the voting membership for mail vote. The ballots are to be returned to the Secretary-Treasurer for official count which is to be approved by the President or whomever he may designate. The candidate receiving the greatest number of votes shall be declared elected."

Your nomination is solicited from the enclosed list of eligible members from the Central district. The term of office is for four years to fill the position now occupied by Dr. Peter Poss whose term expires following the annual meeting in July. Nominations will be declared closed following the April 13 mail delivery.
