The board has unanimously endorsed the proposed changes which will be acted upon by mail vote early in the Fall.

I would call your attention to the following deaths of AAAP members which have been reported to this office since our last mailing: 1) Dr. L. H. Schwarte, one of the original editors of Diseases of Poultry, --an individual who has been an honorary member of the AAAP since its inception; 2) Dr. William A. Higgins of Indianola, Iowa; and 3) Dr. Robert T. Coffland of Fresno, California.

To amend the constitution and by laws of the AAAP follows: Article IV, Section 2, Paragraph 2 - Members

"Have satisfactory moral and ethical standings in the profession and a minimum of three years experience in avian diseases."

"Have satisfactory moral and ethical standings in the profession."

Article IV, Section 2, Paragraph 4 - Associate Members

(a) which now reads

"Veterinarians who are U.S. residents but are not members of the AVMA and persons without a degree in veterinary medicine who have been engaged in some phase of avian pathology for a minimum of three years and who have made significant contributions to the knowledge in this field."

to read

"Veterinarians who are U.S. residents but not members of the AVMA and persons without a degree in veterinary medicine who are engaged in some phase of avian diseases and who have made significant contributions to the knowledge in this field."

REED RUMSEY STUDENT AWARD

The American Association of Avian Pathologists announces a student award. The name of the award will be the "Reed Rumsey Student Award for the Advancement of Avian Medicine."

Applicants must be either students (graduate or professional) or residents pursuing an existing program in a college of veterinary medicine or appropriate department in an academic institution.

- a. Graduate students may be either post-DVM or post-baccalaureate.
- b. Professional students (enrolled in a college of veterinary medicine) may be considered if they also meet the criteria specified below.
- c. Residents must be participating in an avian medicine training program and meet the criteria below.

The award(s) shall be competitive and given in addition to any stipend given by the academic institution.

Initially the award(s) shall be in the amount of \$1,000 — the number to be given will be determined by the AAAP Board each year.

Awards will be based on:

- a. Submission by November 1 each year of a one-to-two-page abstract of a report of original research conducted by the applicant. Those selected to receive the award will be expected to present their research paper at the Avian Section of the Annual Meeting of the American Veterinary Medical Association.
- b. Copy of current curriculum vitae.
- c. Transcript of grades (graduate work unless only a professional student). A progress report will suffice for those in a residency program.
 - d. Narrative statement by the applicant (1-2 pages) outlining career goals, plans for the future, and the significance of their graduate or residency program and research project to these goals.
 - e. A supporting letter from the major professor or someone else from the institution qualified to comment on the merits of the research program and the quality of the applicant.

The awards committee will select winner(s) by mid-December and notify the Scientific Program Chairman so that the presentations may be given at the annual meeting. Application materials should be forwarded to the Chairman of the AAAP Awards Committee, c/o editor of Avian Diseases, D. P. Anderson, College of Veterinary Mcdicine, University of Georgia, Athens, Georgia 30602. Materials must be received by November 1, 1982.
