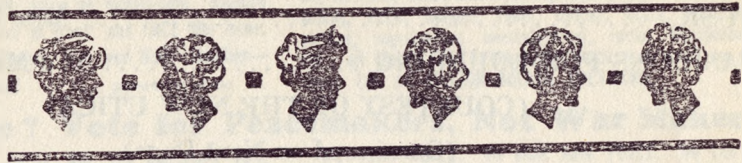

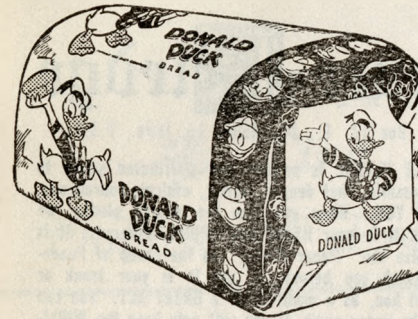

All Nations Peace Pledge

PEACE PLEDGE, for everybody on earth; by R. E. PATTEN, P.O. Box 13, E. Des Moines 16, Iowa. U.S.A.

First I PLEDGE MYSELF to a strenuous effort to awaken within me, my own personality, wisdom and understanding, so that no one can continually hood-wink, deceive or propagandize me with hate and aloofness against any of my fellow human beings anywhere in the world.
LET'S HAVE PEACE

Second I PLEDGE MYSELF to work in harmony with all real sincere PEACE EFFORTS throughout the world; and from the day I SIGN this PLEDGE, I shall talk, assist and VOTE only for PUBLIC OFFICIALS and COMMUNITY LEADERS who will promise and keep their word of honor to WORK earnestly for PEACE and FREEDOM.

Third I PLEDGE MYSELF TO be first, an individual worker, to work at least 2 minutes a day, in some definite way for WORLD PEACE. And then, for mutual strength and integrated cooperation, I shall associate myself with some presently organized, and/or one to be organized, PEACE Organization of my own choice and choosing.

SO AS to sustain and maintain non-violent, non-emotional PEACEFUL organized efforts, I pledge continuous financial assistance to the organization of my choice, in the amount hereon indicated by X in my square.
SPEAK right out, 'SPRESS yourself

- I WILL CONTRIBUTE one cent (1c) a month, 12 months to be paid in advance.
- I WILL CONTRIBUTE one cent (1c) a week, 52 weeks to be paid in advance.
- I WILL CONTRIBUTE one cent (1c) a day, 365 days to be paid in advance.
- IN ADDITION TO any one of the above amounts, I WILL spend all I can afford to spend in my own INDIVIDUAL efforts for PEACE.

NOTE: YOU CAN STAY IN (1c) a day range for one year; then change to (1c) a week or month for the next year; or vice versa. Easily remembered, pay date will be 10 days before, on, or 10 days after your own birthday date. The amount you send voluntarily to the SAME or DIFFERENT PEACE Organization each year

A Fact: THE GREATEST THING in life is PEACE; and the PRESENT GREATEST NEED: non-violent, non-emotional, PEACEFUL, Peace-minded, PEACE seeking INDIVIDUALS with AWAKENED PERSONALITY. Sign the PLEDGE, and KEEP your PROMISE forever LET'S HAVE PEACE

THIS PEACE PLEDGE is printed and distributed solely to awaken, if possible, that deeper, better, ethical, courageous, real-manhood YOU. When you sign the printed pledge, be sure you sign it in your HEART and SPIRIT; otherwise it is NO GOOD. Give the "Paper Pledge" to the group of Peacemakers to which you belong, or put it in your trunk or safety deposit box, as a memento of a GREAT ACT. You can even throw the paper away, if you will only keep the DUPLICATE of it forever in your HEART, so as to develop soul personality which grows only from PEACE WITHIN. You can then enter into the JOY of the Infinite PEACEMAKER.

This "ALL-NATIONS PEACE PLEDGE" is your NEW 20th Century DECLARATION of INDEPENDENCE. This "FORERUNNER of PEACE" Leaflet is the precursor of your NEW 20th Century "Bill of Rights," which have already been prepared for you by your UNITED NATIONS, and known as the "DECLARATION of HUMAN RIGHTS." 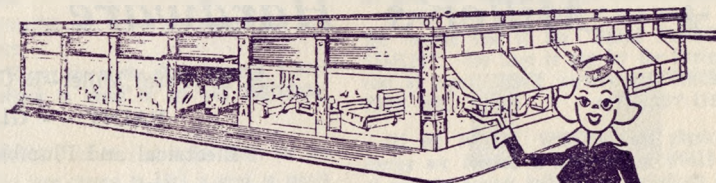
