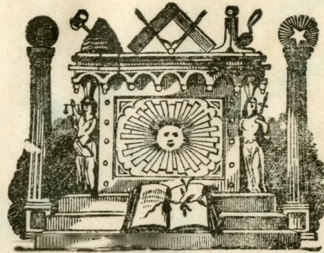


Most Worshipful Sir and Brother:
