Dear Brother:

The checks for \$68 and \$69 we sent you October 13, 1944 were intended for first and second quarter Relief, but I made the mistake to say they were Relief and Grand Lodge dues.

I checked my code and found Grand Lodge dues are payable once a year (June 1).

We had 68 members on our roll July 1 which would make our report correct for that quarter. The second quarter report should have been \$67 because we had two deaths (James B. Mitchell and Clayborn Gould) and one admitted (James A. Claybrook) which would make \$67 due for the second quarter.

The difference in money is \$2.00 for which I ask you to send us due books.

I have been sending you both copies of the report, thinking you sent the Grand Master's copy to him. However, I received a letter from him asking me to send him these reports.
