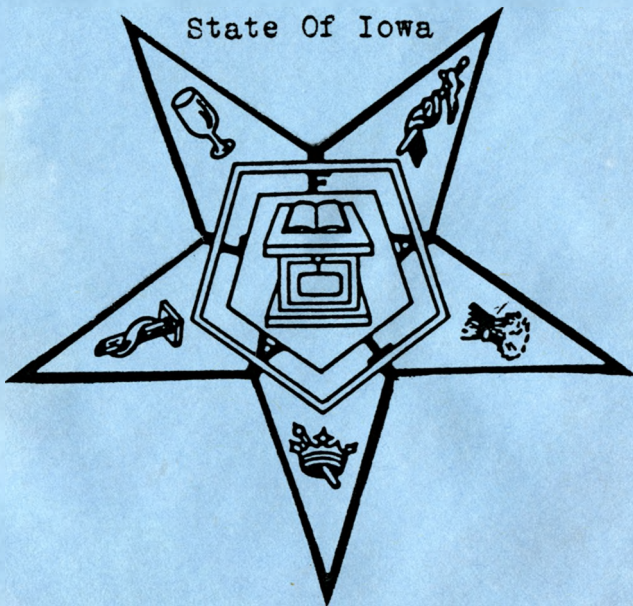

HISTORY

Princess Oziel Chapter was organized at Enterprise, Iowa, September 25, 1906 and relocated in Des Moines, November, 1909. It has furnished Prince Hall Grand Conference with one International Grand Conference Sister, Sue M. Brown, 1922-1924. Sister Brown was also author of "The History of the O.E.S among colored people".

Sister Dorothy B. Bush, Past Grand Worthy Matron, attended Grand Chapters in jurisdictions of Michigan, Massachusetts and Illinois where she observed the Queen of the South. She recommended it to the Iowa Jurisdiction. It was adopted and has become a part of the Iowa Initiation Ceremonies. Under her administration she also recommended that Grand Monies be invested in Bonds and this practice is still being continued.

Sister Haley O. Houston, Past Grand Worthy Matron, gave a Service Award for community involvement. She also brought the Constitution and Code up to date at her own expense.

The Chapter has furnished the Electa Grand Chapter with five Grand Worthy Matrons, viz
