HISTORY

Some time during the Christmas Holidays in 1912 the writer met at Topeka, Kans., Miss Kathryn Johnson, a former public school teacher who called his attention to the work of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People and promised to have some literature sent to him from National headquarters.

About two years later, in the fall of 1914 he received further consignment of literature and a letter from Miss Mary Childs Neary, then National Secretary suggesting that he call together a group of members of both races whom he thought might be interested in establishing a Branch of the movement in Des Moines; and informing him that Dr. Joel E. Spingarn, then chairman of the National Board, would be thru Des Moines in January, 1915 and that if it were desired he might stop off and address the group.

The committee was formed and plans completed for the organization of the Branch upon the visit of Dr. Spingarn on Jan. 20th; but early in January a letter was received from Miss Kathryn M. Johnson, the first National Field Secretary stating that she would arrive in Des Moines a few days prior to Dr. Spingarn to perfect the organization so that all things might be in readiness for the visit of Dr. Spingarn, who was making a transcontinental tour in the effort of the National office to organize Branches in the middle-

west, hence the date of organization was moved forward to Jan. 18th at which time Miss Johnson was present and perfected the organization as Branch No. 25 with thirty three members and the following officers:

Atty. S. Joe Brown, President; A. A. Alexander, Vice President; Mrs. Jessye E. McClain, Secretary; Wade H. McCree, Treasurer; and the following additional members of the Executive Committee: Dr. A. J. Booker, E. R. Hall, Jesse A. Graves, Mrs. S. Joe Brown, Mrs. John L. Thompson, Mrs. J. P. Hamilton, Atty Casper Schenk, Hon. Harvey Ingham and Rev. E. G. Jackson.

On Jan. 20th, Dr. Spingarn arrived and addressed our first public meeting which was held at the Corinthian Baptist Church, at which time he was introduced by the then Governor, Geo. W. Clarke and as a result of which meeting our membership soon grew to 225.

Hardly had the Branch been organized before it was called upon to lead a fight against a "Jim Crow" marriage bill that was introduced in our State Legislature, which it won as it did another ten years later; both with the able assistance of Atty. Casper Schenk, who was then and is now a member of our executive committee.

In the spring of 1916 upon orders from National headquarters we staged a legal battle against the production in Des Moines, of the pernicious moving picture "The Birth of a Nation."

After having procured a resolution from the City Council condemning the film and

directing the Corporation Council to use every effort to prevent its being shown, we filed information upon which warrants were issued and the operators arrested and prosecuted in a trial which lasted for several days; but the court held that the picture did not violate any ordinance of our city, so we were unsuccessful but were highly complimented by the attorneys for the producers, who declared we had given them the hardest fight they had experienced in any city up that time, in which they had been unsuccessfully opposed.

In Nov. 1917, Atty. Brown, after three years' service retired as president, and Mr. E. R. Hall, who had been continuously on the executive committee from the founding of the Branch was elected to succeed him.

His election brought to the support of the Branch a large group of younger people, who organized themselves into a dramatic club, which attained such notoriety that their portaits were published, not only in our local papers but also in the Crisis, thus giving the Branch national prominence.

During Mr. Hall's administration, which also continued for three years, the membership was increased to 425 and the Branch sent Mrs. S. Joe Brown to the first National Anti-Lynching Conference held in New York City and in June 1919 sent the president as our first delegate to a National Conference of the Association held at Cleveland, Ohio and later sent him to another at Atlanta, Ga.

In 1920, Mr. Hall, following the proce-

dent set by his predecessor, retired and was succeeded by Atty. Jas. B. Morris, who also served three years.

During this administration the Branch successfully prosecuted the residential segregation case brought by Miss Dorothy Quail; secured the passage of the resolution of the City Council against segregation at the bathing beaches; secured an amendment to our State Civil Rights Law and established its first Junior Department, with Mrs. S. Joe Brown as its head, who so attracted the attention of the National office that she was invited to appear upon the National Conference Program in Kansas City, Mo. and outline a program for junior work.

Atty. Morris was succeeded by Dr. J. A. Jefferson, who served but one year and was followed by Atty. Chas. P. Howard, who also served but one year; but under whose administration the Branch secured the first conviction under our amended Civil Rights Law; defeated another proposed "Jim Crow" bill in our State Legislature and contributed \$125 to the fund for the defense of Dr. O. H. Sweet and his associates at Detroit, Mich.

Atty. Howard was succeeded in 1925 by our first woman president, Mrs. S. Joe Brown, who during her first year placed the Branch back on the Honor Roll at National Headquarters; secured a second conviction under our Civil Rights Law and represented the Branch at the National Conference at Chicago where she presided and introduced Col. Theodore Roosevelt at

one of the largest mass meetings of that session.

During her second year, she staged a membership contest which increased the membership to 514 and sent herself, Mr. A. P. Trotter and Mrs. Sophia Nichols as representatives to the National Conference held in Indianapolis, Ind.

Mrs. Brown served us for five years and toward the close of her administration planned and presided over an N. A. A. C. P. exhibit in the Educational Building of the State Fair for which we were awarded second place in the adult education section, the first year and the following year under the administration of her successor Mr. A. A. Alexander, she repeated the exhibit and secured first place.

At the expiration of two years service Mr. Alexander was succeeded by Mr. A. P. Trotter and he, after two years by the Rev. Dr. S. M. Riley, who was transferred out of the city shortly after his election and the interest and membership list declined so that upon the election of his successor Mr. F. O. Morrow in Nov. 1935 we had only about forty members enrolled and no money in our treasury.

Mr. Morrow re-established the custom of giving a free trip to the National Conference to the person bringing in the largest number of members in our annual drive and this honor was won for three successive years by Mrs. J. B. Morris, who ably represented us in the National Conferences of 1936, 1937 and 1938; but in 1939 she was surpassed in the membership contest by Mrs. Gladys Carr who was ab-

ly assisted by her husband Mr. Claude Carr, hence the Branch sent all three of them to the National Conference at Richmond, Va. where Mrs. Morris presided over one of the sessions.

In Nov. 1939, Mr. Morrow retired leaving a membership roll of 382 and nearly \$200 in our treasury and Mrs. J. B. Morris was elected our second woman president; and she has begun her work by inviting to Des Moines the representatives of all the Branches in the State to join with us in the celebration of our Silver Anniversary on Jan. 18th, 1940 at which time a State Conference of Branches may be launched.
