CO-OPERATION



True co-operation pre-supposes that each co-operating human being, if able, **WORK** for what he **GETS**, and **GET ALL** he **WORKS** for. And that no man **SHALL EAT** if he **refuses TO WORK**. And that no man shall exact **MORE** of his fellowman's **TIME** in any **transaction, contract or relationship** without being honestly **WILLING** and **anxious** to return for his fellowman an **EQUAL** amount of **TIME** or its equivalent in scientifically determined value. **THIS** test **STANDS** unshaken and **BASIC**. All **BALANCED** minds accept it as an invariable scientific fact. **MINDS** which cannot grasp this **GREAT TRUTH** are sick minds.

Co-operative principles cannot be put into effect by talking. They must be **ACTED** in. And the **ACTION** must be natural. All the things we do **should be, MUST BE** projected into actuality on the wings of the co-operative principle.

I have practiced co-operation for many years. In my failure to exact it of my fellowman, I have been impoverished, mistreated and mulcted.

The **SIMPLE FACT** that we do not know enough to co-operate shows the need of "Co-operative Schools of Truth and Action," conducted as "**ADULT HOME SCHOOLS**" in several different homes in every precinct.

POVERTY, crime, misery, squalor, want, hatred, selfishness, greed are all **PERMANENT FIXTURES** in our present method of dealing with one another. They can be changed only thru developing **CO-OPERATIVE MINDED** human beings.

I **REGRET** to have to admit that the vast majority of all human beings not only turn **EVIL** for **EVIL**, but in some one way or another under lack of enlightenment, turn **EVIL** for good. This is a **FACT** beyond dispute. Over 30 **MILLION** starving people in a land of plenty outstandly attest this fact.

We are morally, mentally and spiritually bankrupt. We need a group of men with broad vision, unswerving ideals, emphatic and determined convictions, and a super-sense of true brotherhood, to set us right. Where are they? Select them and elect them!

The vast majority of those we now have in office and those seeking office are not the type of human beings we need at this crucial time. And if there is not sufficient common sense, vision, courage and general intelligence in the voters to select and elect the right type of men at the various city, county, state and national elections, then dark and dismal days are just ahead.

I come to you symbolizing the type of human being you **need, should** and **must** have before you can change your deplorable social and economic conditions. I come not as an "allwise," "wiseacre," but as one who has a practical workable sufficiency of **Common Sense, Vision and Courage**, together with **Social Consciousness**. That type of human being who is not "puffed up," who seeketh no evil and has no selfish motive. One who knows that all human beings are born "enslaved," "different" and "unequal"—but are entitled to equal opportunity; and that the main and paramount aim and function of government should be to see that every citizen gets a square deal.

I come to you as one crying in the wilderness of mental chaos, trying to persuade you to come out of the wilderness and do those things which will make straight the road of **justice, liberty and equal opportunity**.

I come as one who knows of a certainty that no man should have more than he needs as long as there are millions barely existing with far less than they should have.

I come as one who knows that it will do no good to **pray right**, if you **vote wrong**. And that you cannot vote right if you select the **WRONG TYPE** of men to vote for. And that as long as we American people vote for the two decadent major parties instead of voting for principles, we shall remain **mental infants and economic slaves**.

A Definite Plan of Action Necessary

FROM NOW on I SHALL REQUIRE at least a "co-operative desire response" from all for whom I render any service whatever. I shall hold onto as little "self interest" appeal as possible.

IN RENDERING labor service of whatever kind I shall require an **EQUIVALENT VALUE** in return, based on the science of human relationships. This value may be **BARTER** or the accepted medium of exchange. But it must be **EQUAL VALUE** from the standpoint of **SCIENCE and JUSTICE**.

You must be a member to get the values created thru co-operation. Talk and belief do not fulfill the requirements of co-operation. **YOU MUST "swing into action"—DO SOMETHING!**

To My Black Co-Workers

I appeal to the black members of this projected brotherhood of "Social Reconstruction," to let no individual of our racial group persuade you to vote for anybody on the strength of somebody getting "a job." It is now time we were doing bigger things. We MUST get in the habit of running for elective offices, for within the next few years thousands of black men will be elected to all kinds of offices throughout America, if you encourage the right type.

It makes no difference whether we win or not—WE CAN'T LOSE! And the future is yours, ye Sons of Ham! Because your white brother can neither save himself nor you. And you, oh ye Sons of Ham! must not only save yourselves, but must also save your white brother. To do that you must put "something" into Politics, Government, Economics, Education, Sociology (like you have put into—SONG—MUSIC) which our white brother has left out, and which it is impossible for him to supply in sufficient quantity. You cannot put that "something" in through appointive jobs, but must introduce it through elective office. This "something" is yours by nature, and will be the "saving grace" of America.

Now this "Something" which you are to unconsciously add to American sociological organisms or institutions, to such great benefit to America, is another "X" quantity, but both undiscernable and unexplainable; and which can manifest only through the near simultaneous action on the part of our white brother through a realization of the lack of that "Something" in his governmental social system, and the willingness, and ability of the right type of black brother to enter whole heartedly and soulfully into governmental activity through the elective office channel, and execute the order by supplying that "Something." Did you get that?

I arrive on the scene as the "first fruit," symbolizing "the type," "the measure," "the yard stick." America can be saved through a new social order only; and you are to supply the requisites, the intermediate but absolutely necessary ingredients.

So throughout America, wherever possible, from 1932 on, let no election pass without being represented by the RIGHT TYPE of black and white aspirants to elective office, so as to infuse this "Something" into the social and psychological attitude of the people.

To My White Co-Workers

I APPEAL to the white members of this projected brotherhood of "Social Reconstruction" to let no "dark skins" scare you. Be not deceived by "straw" votes. Millions need work. All must have a sufficiency of food, shelter and clothing. We can not do justice to all unless all cooperate. We need "home town action" with all "lines" left out; not radio talks. Let's get together and act. We need no war; no violence of any kind. But we do need and must have common sense and co-operation.

The things I say of you are said with all kindness. I mean to cast no aspersions, nor to speak disparagingly.

Just as your doctor tells you not to eat certain kinds of food, but to eat certain other kinds on account of your sick physical body, I am telling you to supply your social body—which is sick society, with a certain kind of mental food, resident in a certain type of men, by electing them to office, and not to elect a certain other type which will not, not only not be beneficial to sick America, but positively and destructively injurious. I have no more of a selfish motive in telling you this fact than your doctor has in advising what kind of food you should eat.

There is a psychological element in life known as
COMMON SENSE, Compassion and SOCIAL VISION. Only

a few men, very few throughout all the ages have discovered it. Fewer still have been able to apply it. Unless the type of men and women you select and elect to manage your social institutions have at least a 25% ratio to 100 of this perfect element they are to those social institutions and hence to the social body, as ptomaine or toxic poison to your body.

Remember that the only true and logical help a man can give another man is his continual effort to bring into being a condition of society where every individual will have a sufficiency of the fundamental necessities—which are food, clothing and shelter. Even though you give 50 cents to this man and \$10.00 to that family, and a million dollars to several social organizations which exist to help other groups of men and women

who have been mistreated by a faulty system of human adjustments, even though you do give, it amounts to nothing in the end, because the same social machine which turned out the products you have just helped, **KEEPS ON** turning out more, for others like you to keep on helping—and on, and on and so on.

Why not "**SOCIAL RECONSTRUCTION**" on a basis of justice to every living human being?

All charitable organizations are makeshifts, and exist only on account of the wide prevalence of monstrous injustices in our social system. As long as we accept and support commercialized charity we shall make little, if any, progress toward a **JUST** and **EQUITABLE** social order. Social consciousness must precede this new social order, and you must have a different type of educational technique before the brain cell-seed of social consciousness will even germinate. **WHAT** shall we do?

Now then, if you are in earnest about social and economic betterment you must **NOW** select and elect social scientists to direct you and not mechanical technicians who have no sense of social values.

Why Not Use For Benefit of All ?

We Americans have the largest array of fine machinery in the world. We have the world's greatest mechanical engineers. We equal all in the realm of pure science. But with all this marvelous mechanical technique, in the midst of unbounded natural wealth, we are slowly starving by the millions. 12 million out of work, with thousands more losing their jobs daily. **WHY?** (1st) We have the wrong attitude toward life and our fellowman. (2nd) Our educational system does not **EDUCATE**. (3rd) We elect the wrong type of men to office, and they become tyrannical masters in lieu of helpful and courageous **Servants**.

At least 95% of all men we elect to office are obstructionists (not willfully though), and are void of the **SENSE** of social value. They utterly lack **SOCIAL CONSCIOUSNESS**. The lack of this quality or sense makes them as destructive and useless to the **SOCIAL BODY** as tuberculosis, cancer and leprosy are to the physical body.

That America is socially sick no one will deny. And it has taken over **ONE HUNDRED** years to get this way. But we are here. Sick! Sick!

Abraham Lincoln and Thomas Jefferson, to my mind, America's greatest presidents, saw symptoms of the disease many years ago and warned us in historic messages. We failed to heed the warning. We now need and must have a major operation before we can recover. This operation means a **NEW SOCIAL ORDER** or death in **convulsive revolution**.

This new social order must be started in city, county and state before it can be projected into **national consciousness**. So let us start in Des Moines, and other cities.

Now then all together, you and your neighbor, and your neighbor's neighbor. All of you can vote. If you will vote in accordance with a scientific plan as outlined in my "**SOCIAL RECONSTRUCTION**" program, you can have every man and woman (now voters in Des Moines) employed within 20 months. This is the **outstanding challenge** to your intelligence and your good-will. Where do you stand?

Throughout the ages what the "**can't-ers**" doubted and claimed couldn't be done, the "**DO-ERS**" did. Are you a **can't-er** or a **DO-ER**?

TO BRIEF the situation so you can see it at a glance and clearly remember it, I give you the following **diagnostical delineation**:

We have "**CORRUPTION**" in our "**Political Appendix**," "**GALLSTONES**" in our "**Economic Bladder**," "**MALIGNANT TUMORS**" in our "**Food Distribution Stomach**," "**EXTREMELY LOW BLOOD PRESSURE**" in our "**Financial Veins**" and "**MENTAL HALLUCINATION**" in our "**Mind Dream of Recovery**."

A **MAJOR OPERATION** is absolutely necessary. We can continue to take "**dole dope** and **charity morphine**" and temporarily ease the pain. We can also give "**financial reconstruction cocaine**," and stimulate our system for a while. But if we really want to get well and stay well, without convulsive, devastating revolution, we must have an operation and remove all those "**malignant growths**" which are sapping the very life out of our "**SOCIAL BODY**."

SELFISHNESS, hatred and greed are poisonous and disrupting to **CO-OPERATION**.

If you are unable to readily make a mental adjustment, then you are **TOO SICK** to co-operate. **YOU MUST** attend for a time our "**ADULT HOME SCHOOLS**," which dispense the proper medicine.
