County Farm Bureau office is the office of the county agent—the official representative of the U. S. Department of Agriculture.

Through him and through his office the agricultural adjustment program has been conducted.

The new educational work on the new agricultural adjustment program will likely be done within your own county through your county Farm Bureau.

Valuable pest control and soil building projects and demonstrations are presented by your county Farm Bureau each year in cooperation with the Extension Service, Iowa State College.

The Iowa Farm Bureau Federation Is the Organization of Farmers That . . .

Wrote the warehousing act resulting in Iowa being first state with a practical corn sealing program.

Increased from 25 to 37½ the per cent of the total federal road appropriation available for Farm-to-Market roads.

Prevented repeal of gas tax refund on farm motor fuel.

Prevented legislation which would have raised transportation rates by eliminating truck competition.

Helped organize an association to reduce taxes by promoting sane and economical use of tax money.

Saved thousands of producers titles to their farm homes through the activities of state and county Credit and Debt Conciliation Councils.

Is fighting now to prevent temporary "less than car lot" freight increases in Iowa being made permanent.

Saved farmers thousands (of dollars) by organizing collective purchasing agencies which returned in dividends excessive profit margins or forced reduction of retail prices (especially light petroleum products).
