



The ASA was formed in response to a growing need for closer interaction among American Scientists and Clinicians specializing in the study of the male reproductive tract. As this is a new Society, and funds are not available as yet to initiate publication of our own Journal, we have decided to become affiliated with CIDA (International Committee for the Study of Andrology) whose official Journal is Andrologia.
