FIELD TRIPS SCHEDULED APRIL 4 and 18

Field trips, open to Audubon members and the public, will leave Ames on Sunday morning April 4 and 18 at 7:00. All who wish to participate should meet in the north end of Arlan's parking lot by 7:00. The trip April 4 will visit Littlw Wall Lake and Anderson Lake near Jewell. The trip April 18 will be either to this area or Hendrickson's Marsh. The waterfowl migration has had a slow start this year due to cold weather and ice on the lakes but recent warm weather and waterfowl movement insures our seeing several species of ducks and geese in addition to sparrows, blackbirds, and other early migrants. Bring your binocs, field guides, and a friend. If you need a ride call 232-4869. Details will be available later on a trip to the Red Rock Res. early in May.
