He has awokened in children and adults an appreciation of birds and other natural phenomena that will lead them to enjoy and protect wild things for the rest of their life.

He has specialized in <sup>nature</sup> bird photography since ~~the~~ his retirement as Head of the Department of Education at I.S.U. 16 years ago.

In order to obtain good photographs of wild birds, he has maintained bird feeding stations at the Izaak Walton League and at Gender Woods, among other places, and patiently waited for hours to get the right shot of the right bird.

He has given hundreds of lectures on birds <sup>and conservation</sup>, using his excellent <sup>natural colored slides</sup> ~~Nodachromes~~ pictures to schools, civic organizations and churches, and has even given several sets of bird slides to several Universities.

He has written several pamphlets to share ~~the~~ benefits of his experiences, the latest of which is "Photographing Birds in Their Natural Habitat".

He has been a member of the National Audubon Society and National Wildlife

Federation for many years.

Some of his Kodachromes of birds have recently been published in Lake Mills by Graphic Publishing Company.
