## RIBBON SALAD

2 - 3 oz. pkg. lime jello	1 - 8 oz. cream cheese
5 cups hot water	1 - (1 lb. 4 oz.) crushed pineapple
4 cups cold water	1 cup heavy cream whipped
$\frac{1}{2}$ cup miniature marshmallows	1 cup mayonnaise
1 - 3 oz. lemon jello	2 - 3 oz. pkgs. cherry jello
1 cup pineapple juice	

Dissolve lime jello in 2 cups hot water. Add 2 cups cold water. pour into 14 x 10 x 2 pan. Chill until partially set. Dissolve lemon jello in 1 cup hot water in top of double boiler. Add marshmallows and stir to melt. Remove from heat. Add 1 cup drained pineapple juice and cream cheese. Beat until well blended and stir in pineapple. Cool slightly. Fold in whipped cream and mayonnaise. Chill. Pour in layer over lime jello. Chill until almost set. Dissolve cherry jello in 2 cups hot and 2 cups cold water. Chill until syrupy. Pour over pineapple layer. Chill until firm. Serves 24.

## APRICOT SALAD

2 pkgs. orange jello	2 cups boiling water
1 No. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ can apricots (mashed and drained)	1 No. 2 can pineapple (drained)
1 cup miniature marshmallows	1 cup mixed pineapple and apricot juice

Mix all the above and put in 9 x 13 dish. When firm, top with the following:

1 cup mixed pineapple and apricot juice	
3 tbls. spoons flour	1 beaten egg
$\frac{1}{2}$ cup sugar	2 tbles. butter

Cook this until thick. When cool, add 1 cup cream whipped. Spread over jello and top with grated cheese.

## CHERRY SALAD SUPREME

| 1 - 3 oz. pkg. raspberry jello | 1 - 21 op. can cherry pie filling   |
| 1 - 3 oz. pkg. lemon jello     | 1 - 3 oz. pkg. cream cheese         |
| 1/3 cup mayonnaise             | 1 - 8 3/4 oz. can crushed pineapple |
| 1/2 cup whipping cream         | 1 cup miniature marshmallows        |
| 2 tbls. chopped nuts           |                                     |

Dissolve raspberry jello in 1 cup boiling water. Stir in pie filling. Turn into a 9 x 9 x 2 baking dish. Chill until set. Dissolve lemon jello in 1 cup boiling water. Beat together cream cheese and mayonnaise. Slowly add lemon jello. Stir in undrained pineapple. Whip cream, fold into lemon mixture together with the marshmallows. Spread atop cherry layer and sprinkle with nuts. Chill until set. You can use any flavor jello and pie filling.

## GREEN AND WHITE SALAD

1 pkg. lime jello	1 pkg. Knox gelatin
$\frac{1}{2}$ tsp salt	1 sm. pkg. cream cheese
1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup cottage cheese	$\frac{1}{4}$ cup cult. sour cream <u>or</u>
2 cups boiling water	$\frac{1}{2}$ cup cream whipped
1 cup crushed pineapple drained	
$\frac{1}{2}$ cup pineapple juice with $\frac{1}{2}$ cup water	

Dissolve Knox gelatine in  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup cold water, add salt and 1 cup boiling water. Stir until thoroughly dissolved. Cool. Blend cream cheese and sour cream or whipped cream. Add with cottage cheese to Knox mixture and pour into mold. Chill until set.. Dissolve lime jello in 1 cup boiling water. Add pineapple juice, cold water and drained pineapple. Pour over firm cottage cheese mixture in mold. Refrigerate at least 3 hr. Top with dressing if you wish.

Drain mandarin oranges reserving liquid. Dissolve gelatin in the hot water. Add water to the orange liquid to make 1 cup and add to jello. Chill until slightly thickened. Beat until frothy. Add sherbert and beat until well blended. Fold in orange sections. Pour in baked crust and chill.

## SUNSHINE SALAD

Gelatine base:

1 pkg. lemon jello 1 pkg. orange jello  
2 cups boiling water 10 cut up marshmallows or 40  
1 $\frac{1}{2}$  cups cold water miniature ones  
1 #2 can crushed pineapple (drained)  
2 bananas diced

Topping:

1 egg beaten 2 tbls. flour  
2 tbls. butter  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup sugar  
1 cup pineapple juice 1 cup cream whipped  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup shredded cheese

For base dissolve both packages of gelatin in hot, add cold water and cool until consistency of unbeaten egg white. Add fruit and marshmallows. Pour into 9 x 13 pan. Chill.

For topping combine first 5 ingredients into sauce pan and cook until thick. Cool. Fold in whipped cream and spread over chilled gelatine. Sprinkle with cheese. Pour in mold. Chill. Easy to double.

## GOLDEN FRUIT SALAD

2 - 3 oz. pkgs orange jello	2 cups boiling water
1½ cups cold water	1 - 11oz. can mandarin oranges
1 - 8 3/4 oz. can apricot halves	
1 cup white seedless grapes	2 large bananas sliced

Dissolve gelatin in boiling water, add cold water. Chill until syrupy. Drain fruit reserving 1 cup liquid. Fold fruit into chilled jello and pour into 12 x 7 x 2 pan. Chill over night and frost with Fluffy Topping. Top with ¼ cup grated cheese

### Fluffy Topping

6 tbls. sugar	2 tbls. corn starch
1 slightly beaten egg	1 cup reserved fruit liquid
2 tbls butter	1 tbls. lemon juice
1 cup heavy cream or 2 oz. pkg. dessert topping mix	whipped

Combine sugar and corn starch in heavy saucepan. Blend in egg and liquid. Cook, stirring constantly, over low heat until thickened. Remove from heat, stir in butter and lemon juice. Cool. Fold in whipped cream or topping mix.

## PINEAPPLE - BANANA SALAD

1 pkg. lemon jello  
2 bananas

## PERFECTION SALAD

2 envelopes unflavored gelatin	2 tsp. lemon juice
$\frac{1}{2}$ cup sugar	$1\frac{1}{2}$ cup finely shredded cabbage
1 tsp salt	1 cup celery
$2\frac{1}{2}$ cup boiling water	$\frac{1}{2}$ cup pimento
$\frac{1}{2}$ cup vinegar	$\frac{1}{2}$ cup chopped green pepper

Thoroughly mix gelatin, sugar and salt, stirring until sugar dissolves. Add lemon juice and vinegar, cool. When mixture begins to thicken add remaining ingredients. Pour into 9 x 5 x 2 pan. Garnish with ripe olives.

## KRAUT SALAD

2 - 303 cans kraut drained	1 jar pimentos (chopped)
1 cup chopped onion	1 cup chopped celery
1 cup sugar	

Mix the above together and let stand over night.

1 cup green or red pepper strips	
1 cup sliced small dill pickles	
1 cup sliced small sweet pickles	
1 cup turnips cut in strips	1 No. 2 can okra

1 cup celery strips	1 cup onion strips

### Sauce for Antipasto:

3/4 cup cider vinegar	1 cup corn oil

Bring to a boil, add vegetables and cook for 10 minutes. Let cool and serve. Will keep 3 - 4 weeks in refrigerator.

## SOUR CREAM POTATO SALAD

7 med. potatoes cooked in jackets, peeled and sliced to make 6 cups  
 $\frac{1}{3}$  cup clear French or Italian dressing  
 $\frac{1}{3}$  cup sliced green onion and tops  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  cup sliced celery                      4 hard cooked eggs  
1 cup mayonnaise                               $\frac{1}{2}$  cup dairy sour cream  
 $1\frac{1}{2}$  tsp. horseradish mustard           $\frac{1}{3}$  cup diced pared cu cumber  
salt and celery seed to taste

While potatoes are warm, pour dressing over and then chill for 2 hours. Add celery and onions. Chop egg whites and add. Seive yolks; reserve some for garnish. Combine remaining egg yolk with mayonnaise, sour cream and mustard. Fold into salad. Add salt and celery seed. Chill salad for 2 hours. Add diced cucumber, mix. To trim, sprinkle reserved yolks and sliced onion tops over top.
