

## Material to find in Iowa

These species certainly did or do occasionally occur in the state:-

- (Nelson's Sparrow) 10 sight records 12. M.; Cedar Falls.  
(W. Henslow's Sparrow) Lyda Jones; specimen Univ. of I. ? mine reporters in Anderson.  
Lark Bunting numerous in N.W. in 1927. several earlier reports a.g. Anderson coll.  
Brewer's Blackbird several reports  
Hooded Warbler several reports of specimens taken Grinnell 1888  
(Worm-eating Warbler) Savage coll.  
(Connecticut Warbler) Savage coll.  
N. Prairie Warbler Reported by Peck & Berry.  
Sycamore Warbler Specimen by Berry not found; a few reports recently  
(White-eyed Vireo) Savage coll.  
E. Mockingbird nested Valley June; numerous reports  
(Bewick's Wren) Savage coll.  
American Raven formerly occurred  
(Adrian Flycatcher) Savage coll.  
Red-shafted Flicker About a dozen reports or records of specimens - none seen by me! a.g. Anderson coll.  
W. Burrowing Owl numerous breeding records in north-west a.g. Anderson coll.  
Louisiana Paroquet formerly occurred.  
(Long-billed Curlew) Fairfield coll. specimen cited by H.C.O.  
Black Rail Water's coll. Cedar Falls?; reported by Nutting; nesting - Berry; reported by Prager, Surge, & Jones.  
(Ferruginous Rough-leg) Iowa City?; a.g. Anderson coll.; Cedar Falls?  
Greater Scaup Duck many reports.  
Cinnamon Teal Cedar Falls?; a.g. Anderson coll.;  
(Trumpeter Swan) Cedar Falls?; Smith coll. Osceola?  
(White-faced Glossy Ibis) Rich coll. Sioux City?; allent coll. Tinnard coll.  
Western Grebe J.E.R. Roberts sight iden;

These species probably occurred and in some cases the specimens have been reported but they have not yet been examined by me.

- McCown's Longspur Throater reports of a common migrant, Pottawattamie Co. Specimen identified by him.  
Montana Junco several reports - no specimens found!  
Bachman's Sparrow (A.O.U. Check-List) based on record by Keyes & Williams?  
Baird's Sparrow Reported by Jones, Kelsey, Throater.  
(Arctic Towhee) specimen youngworth coll.  
Grey-crowned Rosy Finch Reported by Halliott specimen not saved but description OK.  
Lazuli Bunting Reported by youngworth  
E. Blue Grosbeak Anderson's coll.; Reported by Bennett - Sioux City; seen by youngworth.

Sprague's Pipit Throater reported one collected in Pottawattamie Co.  
7 - Chesnut-backed Bluebird several vague references; reported by Berry for Cedar Rapids.  
Common Rock Wren D.M. Hagen; Mc Gregor; Decatur Co. - Trappe; breeding Sioux City - Rich;  
(Carolina Chickadee) specimens coll. by Berry & Bailey?  
Say's Phoebe Throater - rare summer visit in Mills Co.; Berry one & coll. Hawarden, Sioux Co.  
Arctic Three-toed Woodpecker W.H. Savage - 1 record; Watson - 12. M.  
Lewis's Woodpecker Reported from Sioux City  
Nuttall's Poor-will Reported Grinnell - Kelsey - on hearing call; nest found Pottawattamie - Throater - bird shot up.  
Great Gray Owl Trappe reported at second-hand from Oakdale, W.B. Savage & David L. Savage report it  
American Hawk Owl Berry reports taking specimens, Linn Co. & seeing another one.  
(Brunnich's Murre) two records. Pellet - Atlantic; Hower - Johnson County.  
E. Ground Dove Reported by Paulsen  
Laughing Gull several indefinite reports  
Red Phalarope Berry - rare migrant - Hawarden, Sioux Co.
