The Rosene Bird Collection at Ogden .--

The small private collection contained in the home of Mr. Walter Rosene of Ogden consists of 22 specimens of mounted birds, mostly hawks, waterfowl, and upland game birds.

A Western Red-tailed Hawk in the dark phase is perhaps of chief interest as a Boone County record. Other unusual specimens include a Duck Hawk, a Pigeon Hawk, a Montana Horned Owl and an Odd-squaw all secured in Boone County during the last 20 years. The & Marketing
