

The following is a list of 124 species of birds observed by Walter Rosene, Sr., Robert Walker, and Walter Rosene, Jr., on May 14, 1933 in Boone County, Iowa.

This is believed to be the largest list of birds ever noted in Iowa in one day by a single observer or a single party of observers.

The field trip was made between 5:00 A. M. and 7:00 P. M., except for one hour rest at noon. The weather was clear and warm.

Ten species of ducks, twelve species of sparrows, and fifteen species of warblers were seen. No rare records were established, and a number of common birds such as the Least Bittern, Great Blue Heron, Green Heron, Wilson's Snipe, Solitary Sandpiper, Marsh Hawk, Red-shouldered Hawk, Barred Owl, Great Horned Owl, Yellow-bellied Sapsucker, Hummingbird, Traill's Flycatcher, Grasshopper Sparrow, Lark Sparrow, Cliff Swallow, Cedar Waxwing, Yellow-throated Vireo, Grinnell's Water-Thrush, and Willow Thrush were not found.
