Dear Dr. Nelson:

I received a letter from Mr. Leopold to the effect that you were working on a revision of the Genus *Colinus*. Unfortunately my collection of museum skins from Wisconsin is extremely limited, and is in the possession of Professor Wagner of the Zoology Department, University of Wisconsin. I have no Iowa skins at the present time, but I think that in the course of some months I might be able to get a series.

Relative to the introduction of the Texan sub-species, Leopold has the most authentic data of anyone I know, and since you are apparently in touch with him, you probably have, or will get the most reliable information on this topic that we have. I haven't made inquiries at all myself, but shall be glad to send you any data I happen to run across.
