I have your letter of January 11 regarding Errington's manuscript on pheasants and quail.

I hope that you may be able to place it there although I understand that the AUK is at least a year and possibly more behind in publication.

If you desire prompter publication, I do not know just what the status of the WILSON BULLETIN is although I think it is a little bit faster.
