Dear Dr. Boone:

In answer to your question in the postscript of your letter to Mr. Camerle.

It would, in my opinion, be good policy for the Department to go as far as their money will let them in the installation of management improvements on private farms in exchange for public shooting under regulation. We both know, of course, that present funds will not allow of any large extension of this system, but by extending it as far as the funds will allow, the issue will be brought to a head and the public may be forced to think by what financial means they want to extend it further. A dollar will go much farther now, of course, than at any other time because of the relief labor available, so that the set-up is for the moment better than it was at the time of the Game Survey.

I am sending a copy of this to Errington for his information.
