Dear Paul:

At the time we were corresponding about the manuscript on the quail frontier, we were short of weights from the truly northern edge of the range.

Irv Buss has obtained this winter 132 weights from Dunn County which could, I think, be called a frontier range. He offers to let us use them. I thought I would let you know that this particular gap in our data no longer exists. It occurred to me that even if we did not go ahead with the whole comprehensive paper on the frontier, that a less ambitious paper showing transition in weights from the Gulf to the northern edge of the range would be interesting, and in such a limited paper we might ask Irv to join us. In his present position he might get more weights. I would, of course, be willing to go ahead with the more comprehensive paper if you feel like it.

Classes have cut me off from further work on the Prairie du Sac paper, and it will probably not be finished until June.
