I am ashamed of my slowness. The data on the Prairie du Sac pyramid are not yet all in my hands, and I wanted to submit the proposed new section to you before judging whether it's any good. I hope to hit the thing hard within the next few weeks.

Naturally, I have been studying your draft and am ^{cave}thoroughly convinced we have something, but some of your ~~cautions~~ seem to me of doubtful validity, partly because the areas are too small, and partly because where one species greatly preponderates, it would naturally carry the other with it in any joint curve of combined populations.

The prospect of publishing this as a Wisconsin Experiment Station bulletin has, I think, disappeared, but I think we need not worry about an outlet if we can once get it into shape to suit us.

This is not an alibi. I am just plain late.
