We have your letter of October 13 regarding the
Prairie du Sac quail census project.

Arrangements for paying Mr. Albert Gastrow's
salary have been made so that the payroll report will
be prepared at the end of each month. His check would
then be sent to him during the ensuing month. However,
we still have to clear with the bureau of personnel
to hire him as a temporary employee. This is being done
now and we will contact you for any necessary details.

I will be happy to work with Fred Hamerstrom in the
supervision work in consultation with Paul Errington
and would like to visit the project and contact Mr. Gastrow
some time in the near future if Mr. Hamerstrom plans a
trip up there.

As you will remember, the final plans listed you as
responsible for preparation of the quarterly reports and I
was to prepare the findings for publication. The quarterly
report goes to the biological survey and I am today asking
Mr. M. O. Steen whether a single report for the five-month
period would be satisfactory. I will advise you of his
reply.

As far as my published material is concerned, that
can be planned and publication arranged at a later date.

I believe this will answer your immediate questions.
Action will be taken to get things started.
