This is a register of State agencies and public school systems (other than those filing Form 441) whose Statements or Assurances of Compliance with the Regulations for Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 have been found acceptable for the purposes of current application approvals. This register is composed of four lists:

- A. State agencies which have filed a Statement of Compliance which has been considered acceptable by the Office of Education for the purpose of approving applications and State plans involving Federal financial assistance. Further review of these Statements of Compliance is being made by DHEW Regional Offices for coordination with Departmental criteria.
- B. State agencies which have filed Assurance of Compliance (Form HEW-441) for State-operated agencies.
- C. Public School Systems which have filed a court order.
- D. Public School Systems which have filed a voluntary Plan of Desegregation which has been accepted by the U.S. Commissioner of Education.
