GEESE - FAIRLY NORMAL NUMBERS, WITH NOT TO MANY OF ANY SPECIE STENHERE FIRST SEEN WERE TWO WEEKS LATER THAN LAST YEAR, DUCKS - MOUGO IN IN REAL GOOD NUMBERS BY 3/20. AGAIN THEY WERE LATE 2-3 WEEKS. ALL SAECTES EXCEPT RED BREASTED MERGANISER, FHAVE BEEN SEEN.

HAWKS - NUMEROUS RED-TAILS HAVE BEEN SEEN IN LATTER MARCH,

- MARSH HAWKS HAVE BEEN IN GOOD NUMBERS.

KESTRELS - HAVE BEEN THE HIGHLIGHT SO FAR, ON 3/3425.30 SEEN AND ON 3/20 35-40 SEEN. OH ONE STRETCH OF HIGHWAY 92 WE AVERAGED ONE EVERY HAIF MILE FOR GMILES, I HOPE THIS REALLY MEANS AN INCREASE. EASTERN PHORE - ON 3/24 IN SNOW FULFFICS ONESCEN AT 20 FT FLIRTING FROM PRANCH TO BRANCH ABOUG FLOOD WATCH WAS QUITE STRANGE. WOODY BROWN'S LIST OF IOWA BIRDS HAS AN EARLY DATE OF 3/3. THE PRESENDING NIGHT ON 3/23 HAD BEEN WARM. I HOPE HE MAPPE IT.
