Some birds facts observed

Slate colored junco - I saw first of season on 10-2-97  
and banded one on 10-9, in my backyard.

Hermit thrush seen in Jean Braley's backyard 10-30-97.

Yellow rumped Warbler also ~~seen~~ <sup>seen</sup> on 10-30-97

In both of our backyards we saw ~~one~~ <sup>3</sup> red breasted nuthatch on same day, 10-30-97. Jean has 1 male + 1 female. They are still making daily visit to our feeders. I Banded one on 11-01-97

Orange crowned warbler were seen during 10-2 & 10-14  
in both backyards. No more than 2 were seen at one time.

Ruby crowned Kinglet was in my backyard on 10-14-97

Swainson's thrush was seen 10-27-97 in Jean's backyard.

Palm warbler seen in Jean Braley's backyard at 4:30 PM  
on 11-17-97 at a distance of 30 feet. Description, very

yellow on rump and yellow underneath with streaking on breast. it was bobbing its tail.

Red tailed hawk. On Sunday Nov 16 going to church at 10:00 AM going south on ~~Highway~~ Highway 59 for 12 miles, we saw bred tailed hawks sitting on poles, wires or trees along the road. Coming home at 2:30 PM on the same road we counted 9 red tailed hawks.
