This bird was seen briefly, as it sailed through the canyon in the lower part of the park. I only had the bird in view 3-5 seconds; my first impression, based on flight style, was that it was a kite, and the details I saw supported that initial impression. The tail was long and dark; as the bird sailed past it turned its head toward me, and the head was a very pale gray. The bird was fairly low, and because of the angle, I did not get any impression of its wing shape.

Kites could well have shown up near Greenwood Park earlier, but I wasn't able to check.

On the 24th I twice observed a kite in a tree with twigs in its mouth, and on both occassions it moved from that tree into a second tree where the bird appeared to be working on a nest.

1 25 May Olivet Baptist Church I had checked this site several times; this was the first time I found a kite there.
