throat and nape. The wings as well as the tail was dark and the tail was bordered with white outer
feathers.

Details: These two birds were back at the same location where they nested and raised young last year. The male was quite active in calling to the female who was looking for a nesting site. Black head, bill, nape and throat with dark greenish-blackish-blue tail and secondaries. White belly; black legs.
