On 25 November one of my students found a weak, but still alive, fall plumaged male (?) Bobolink north of Zeiring in Story County, Iowa. It died but is now in the Iowa State University collection and it has to be very late for that species.

I suppose that Pete Peterson coordinates records for the state of Iowa but I have not had a chance to contact him. I should be able to pick up a number of interesting records for central Iowa from students here and also a good picture of the spring migration from my ornithology students.
