- Common Loon-1 at Hallett's Quarry, 17 May (with HZ, et al.)
- Horned Grebe-2 at Tomahawk M., 23 May
- Western Grebe-1 at Hendrickson M., 31 May (found by HZ)
- Least Bittern-2 at Camp Dodge, Johnston, 19, 26 May (Jane Schuster (fide)JJD)
- 1 at Iowa Lake M., Kossuth Co., 19 May (Steve Fairbairn fide JJD)
- 2 at Gladfelter M., Hancock Co., 21 May (Steve Fairbairn fide JJD)
- Cattle Egret-1 at Harrier M., 26 Apr

  6 at Hawkeye W. A., 14 May, (Neil Bernstein fide JJD)
- Glossy Ibis-1 at Thorpe P., Winnebago Co., 26 May (Gian Dodici, see attached sheet with details)
- Snow Goose-10 (6 blue, 4 snow) at Hallett's Quarry, 25 May 4 at Harrier M., 29 May
  - Bar-headed Goose-1 at Swan Lake, 22 Feb (Terry Hulsebus fide JJD)
  - Egyptian Goose-1 at Ottumwa, 19 March (Steve Toon (fide) JJD)
- Turkey Vulture-nest with 2 eggs, near Promise City, Wayne Co., 13 May (Duane Bedford fide Daryl Howell)
  - ✓Bald Eagle-96 at Saylorville Res. on 21 March 20 moving north at Saylorville Res. on 26 March
- Cooper's Marsh-adult on nest in Ames, 8 May, 10 May, 22 May, nest still intact but adult not seen on 29 May
- Sharp-shinned Hawk-1 in Ames, 7 March
- Red-tailed Hawk-adults on 2 nests in Pottawattamie Co., 14 and 17 March

- Greater-Prairie Chicken-43 males on 8 leks in Adair, Decatur, and Ringgold counties (fide Iowa Dept Nat. Resources)
- Yellow Rail-1 flushed west of Spirit Lake, 10 April (Maury Muhm via Doug Harr and fide JJD). Small rail, weak flight, white wing patches
  - Sandhill Crane-2 near South Skunk River west of Colfax, 5 April
  - Killdeer-31 flying over campus in snowstorm, 24 March
  - Marbled Godwit-1 at Dunbar S1., 23 May (cinnamon wing linings and lack of any broad white band on tail seen when bird flushed)
  - Dunlin-20 s. of Auburn, 23 May
  - Long-billed Dowitcher-3 at Colo ponds, 17 May (with HZ, P & R Allen, et al.), flushed, keek call heard
  - Common Snipe-1 at Doolittle Prairie, Story County, 9 May
  - American Woodcock-1 at St. Anthony, 2 March, Larry Stone
  - Red-necked Phalarope-1 s of Auburn, 23 May
  - Black Tern-1 at Hallett's Quarry, Ames, 8 May (first) 82 at Harrier M., 24 May (most)
    - Mourning Dove-5 in Ames, 9 March; 7 on 10 March (overwintered)
  - Andersen and Liessa Thomas fide JJD) (they also thought they saw two young birds but I have not been able to confirm i.d., will keep
  - Checkiwgl's-widow-1 heard well, calling in Cedar Rapids on 22 May (Neil Bernstein fide JJD).
    - Tom-Neil sent me note about this one. Bird was calling in his yard which adjoins a golf course in Cedar Rapids. Neil is an ornithologists and is familiar with the call of this species as well as other goatsuckers. Just heard the one night.
  - Pileated Woodpecker-2 at nest, Ledges S.P., 29 Apr 2 adults, feeding young in nest, 25 May
