Pomarine Jaegers---All three birds seen at the same time floating on the lake. All three looked to be the same very dark shade of brown--almost black--very evenly colored with no pale areas on the head or nape. The two seen in flight had very prominent white crescents on the underwings at the bases of the primaries and much fainter white areas on the upperwings. One flew close enough to see its' bi-colored bill.
