I believe we are to send fall migration reports to you. I don't know as there is too much to report from here. Of most interest to me was a the American Woodcock seen on September 12<sup>th</sup> the Black-throated-blue Warbler here November 2 & 17; and the small flock of Snow Buntings seen on November 14. Sparrow migration was rather disappointing this fall. I missed many of the usual species seen. Tree Sparrows seem quite numerous and I believe Junco are here in the usual numbers though <sup>due</sup> lack of a snow cover they haven't come to our yards here in town to feed as yet. Saw a huge flock of Bluebirds (mostly Grackles I would say) as they apparently left for the south on Nov. 13. Saw a few Bluebirds in October.
