Also I received the following report late from wildlife biologist Glenn Jones, Rockwell City La "A pair of Glossy Ibis at Blackhawk Marsh just south of Lakewood La on April 19, 1976. Saw a pair near the same place spring of 1975." He also reported a "mated pair of Pileated Woodpeckers while trout fishing on Coldwater Creek N.W. of Clearah June 5-6, 1976. The nesting cavity was in a dead elm, about 100 yards south of the entrance of Coldwater Cave."

Two ladies earlier reported the Glossy Ibis to me and I sent the report to Woody & told him to use his own judgement tho I considered them reliable. He omitted that. Should I send a "rare bird" documentation to Glenn? I think I will and have him mail it directly to you since Ibis are indeed rare in Iowa.
