Snow Goose:one white phase near Sanborn on 1 Jul  
Hooded Merganser:3 young at Mill Creek S.P. on 3 Jun  
Cooper's Hawk: nests with young near Luxembourg on 19 Jun and near  
Sutherland on 30 Jun  
Broad-winged Hawk:2 in Yellow River Forest during Jun  
Upland Sandpiper:1-4 in Buena Vista, Cherokee, Clay, Pocahontas, and  
O'Brien Co's  
Willet:1 at Mill Creek S.P. on 15 Jul  
Winter Wren:2 at White Pine Hollow on 1 Jun  
Veery:1 in Yellow River Forest on 20 Jun  
"Lawrence's" Warbler:1, apparently paired with Blue-winged Warbler,  
carrying food and giving alarm calls in Yellow River Forest on 20 Jun  
Chestnut-sided Warbler:male and female carrying food and giving alarm calls  
in Yellow River Forest on 24 Jun. A second male was also in Yellow River  
Forest during Jun. A male was at the Coon Creek W.M.A. (Winneshiek County)  
on 21 Jun.  
Yellow-breasted Chat:1 in Yellow River Forest during Jun
