The follow list of birds I observed around the Riverton refuge unless otherwise stated on 2-13-77.

Two rough-legged hawks

Three red tailed hawks

Merlin hawk

Several Kestrel in Farragut + Riverton area.

2 great horned owls seen mating west of Shenandoah in trees by the East Nishnabotna River 2-13-77.

Snowy owl seen this winter a few times by Don Priebe between Farragut + Riverton.

Barred owl sited along East Nishnabotna River west of Shenandoah.

A few horned lark seen along roadsides. Not near as plentiful as in the past years.

Sited first Am. robin of winter in Shenandoah 2-11-77.

Cedar waxwing abundant in Shenandoah.

2 loggerhead shrike

Red-winged blackbirds extremely scarce this winter

American goldfinch abundant in Shenandoah at feeders and in the Riverton area.

Tree sparrows plentiful everywhere.

Harris sparrow abundant

a few White crowned sparrow
