Jim Fuller reported early arrivals at Lacy Keos. the last of April on IA-BIRDS that I also had at Sharon Bluffs on 5/1: Swainson's Thrush, Nashville W., Black-throated Green, Ovenbird, and Baltmore Oriole. Also Henslow's Sp. in Van Buren Co. Quite a difference from last year's non-arrival.

As you can see, I didn't find any good shorebird spots nearby this spring. Too much water, not enough shore... The woods were so good this year I couldn't have pulled myself away if I had!

It wonder what triggers a big over migration like this year? Hooded, worm easting, Cervlean (I did miss those this year!), end parvlas. Parvlas probably don't quite fit in the same category as the others because of their northern pop-, but they sure were easy to find this year in the NW.
