Details: Fast flying gray bird with long pointed wings, projecting wrists, square tail, white on wing on trailing edge from body to "elbow." Drifted out of sight quickly but the bird was

not up very high and got a good look at it.

2 27 May Polk Co. - 1601 Pleasant St., WDM Pam Allen Details: I was hanging out laundry and happened to glance up and saw two adult Mississippi Kite's slowly riding a thermal right over our yard and house. I'm probably one of the few people who wear their binoculars while hanging up laundry during migration periods! The long pointed wings and squarish tails and almost uniform gray underparts (tail was darker than underwing pattern) were observed. Only briefly got a glimpse of the partial white trailing edge on the upperwings of the soaring birds. Haven't checked to see if there have been any other sightings at either Fred Crane's home or at the Olivet Baptist Church where these birds nested one year but I think Phil Walsh saw a Mississippi Kite flying over his home about this same date.
