General Notes: Spring of 1999 was early but cool in northwest Iowa. There were few, if any, freezing temperatures after late April, and green-up was approximately 10 days ahead of normal. After a dry winter and early spring, precipitation increased through April and May, leaving the region 3-4" above average precipitation for this time of year. Some migratory bird species appeared earlier than would be expected, while others seemed to be right on schedule. Warbler migrations were particularly good in early-mid May (17 species at Kettleson Hogsback WMA, Dickinson Co. on May 14-15).
