A few additional notes on the Fall Report

The <u>Peregrine Falcon</u> seen at Lake Manawa was probably one of the birds from the Omaha Peregrine Project. No marks were seen on the bird, however, I'm told these marks fade rapidly.

The Black Scoter seen at Lake Manawa was swimming with a Surf Scoter. It was distinguished by the completely black body, rounded head as compared with Surf Scoter, Dark crown and pale cheek area. The Surf Scoter had a dark head with distinct whitish patches on the face.
