Comments: The scoter migration through central Iowa was the best ever and was noticeably on the early side. Several were shot, so I didn't feel it was necessary to detail all of the sightings. Gull numbers, especially Bonaparte's, were extremely low at Saylorville this fall, except that large numbers of Ring-billed and Herring gulls showed up the last three days on Nov. The shorebird and warbler migrations were also very poor in central Iowa. The fall has been quite mild, with Saylorville still mostly open on 30 Nov.
