12-1-76 Common Bobwhites: a bevy of 10 or more south of Newton.

12-6-76 Oregon Juncos: 4 arrived at a Newton residence to stay thru Jan '77 Beautiful birds!
12-15-76 Photographed Snowy Owl in plow field southwest of Pleasantville.

Mockingbirds: one in Jasper County -- one, Morth\*Shore\*Redrock\*Lake\* Marion County
Northern Harrier, Marsh Hawk, female ... North shore of Red Rock Lake.

I am very concerned about the very few Hawks and Owls I see while in the fields. Gladys Black and I try watch for them in Marion and Jasper County and we have very little to put in our records. I cover many counties, north and south from Newton when wife and I drive in many areas of IOwa. A year ago we saw many Kestrals (Sparrow Hawks). But last fall and this winter we see one only once in a while. We often drive to Centerville to visit relatives, if we see one or two now we are lucky on that drive. Make the lost lad as many as 16 Kastala for the second on the 80 mile drive.
