Rough-legged Hawk--One near Decorah on Dec. 30 and two near Castalia on Feb. 5.

Am. Kestrel--One near Decorah on Jan. 23.

Horned Lark--Numerous flocks found in January and February in the northeast.

Gray Jay--<sup>one</sup> Present near Decorah all winter.

Carolina Wren--One at Effigy Mounds on Jan. 1.

Pine Siskins--A few around Decorah all winter.

Lapland Longspur--A flock of 23 observed in Howard Co. on Jan. 22.

Snow Bunting--A number of small flocks found in Howard and Chickasaw Cos. on Jan. 22.
