## **FALL 1990 FIELD REPORTS**

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Fall was for the most part very warm and mild and migration was certainly different than it has been in the past few years. The loon movement has been fantastic, as evidenced by the 200+ commons at Coralville Reservoir on 4 November, but grebes have been rather scarce. Were there a ton of buff-breasted sandpipers or did I just finally learn how to find them? Many birds seemed to keep on moving with the warm weather and good flying conditions. Warblers appeared in waves this fall, more like spring movement than fall. Vireo migration was above normal, however, as evidenced by the seven Philadelphias in my yard. There were also an above normal number of calling Empidonax flycatchers for the post-breeding season. The fall season has also been rather normal in the somewhat early arrival of a few winter residents and the lingering of a few summer nesters.
