Field Reports - SUMMER 1990 entered

Records listed below are from —

Allamakee County: Effigy Mounds National Monument (EMNM) and Yellow River Forest

Clayton County: Sny Magill Breeding Bird Atlas Block, southwest of McGregor

Howard County: Hayden Prairie

Winneshiek County: Cardinal Marsh

SPECIES DATA

Green-winged Teal: One male was at Cardinal Marsh on June 20.

Common Goldeneye: A female remained at Cardinal Marsh from the spring and was seen on June 4 and 20.

Ruddy Duck: 18 were seen at Cardinal Marsh on June 4 and a few pairs remained through the season; 6 adults and 5 juveniles were seen here on July 30.

Osprey: 1 was seen over Cardinal Marsh on July 30, but it did not linger.

Bald Eagle: 1^{adult} was seen as it flew over the visitor Center at EMNM on July 21.

Black-billed Cuckoo: An adult was seen feeding a juvenile (out of the nest) at the Sny Magill Atlas Block, Clayton Co., on July 11.

Yellow-bellied Sapsucker: present at EMNM throughout the period with a pair at a nest hole on June 1.

SUMMER 1990 (continued)

- Pileated Woodpecker: 3 seen at EMNM on June 30.
- Acadian Flycatcher: 5, including one on a nest were found at EMNM on June 11 and again on June 21; the nest was deserted on June 23 but an adult was still seen in the vicinity. This species was found only along the Yellow River in EMNP.
- ~~Alder~~ Flycatcher: ^(heard and seen) found in Clayton, Howard, and Winneshiek counties during the period.
- Least Flycatcher: ^(heard and seen) 3 found in Snyder Magill Atlas Block, Clayton County on June 6.
- Sedge Wren: 4 were heard and seen at Hayden Prairie on June 27 and 16+ on June 30.
- Wood Thrush: High count was 9 at EMNM on June 30.
- Cerulean Warbler: Present at EMNM throughout the season with a high count of 10 on June 21; 2 were seen along Paint Creek, Yellow River Forest, on June 23.
- American Redstart: common at EMNM with a high count of 16 on June 21.
- Ovenbird: High counts were 8 at EMNM on June 21 and 8 in another EMNM locality on June 30.
- Kentucky Warbler: It was seen repeatedly along the Yellow River, EMNM with a high count of 4, including a territorial pair on June 21.
