**MESSAGE**

I thought you might be interested. On June 12-'9 one sandhill crane was observed on the Riverton Area. No additional sightings were made but possibly because the area sustained heavy flooding shortly thereafter.

Also, since the heavy rains of the evening of 7-25-90 (we received 10-15 inches locally) there have been many shorebirds at Riverton and in flooded crop fields up and down the river valley. It is amazing how fast they can capitalize on excellent foraging conditions. Their<sup>fall</sup> migrations must begin almost as soon as the spring migration stops.
