One male was observed with a flock of Lesser Scaup. Comparing head shape of the two species, the Greater Scaups' head was more rounded. It lacked the sharp corner on the rear of the crown. Lighting was not good enough to distinguish any head color between the two species. Could easily be confused with Lesser. Observed at approx. 100yds.

24 APR 1995 Pleasant Creek L Linn Co.

One female was observed at a very close range. Approx. 25 yds. This bird was feeding near shore in shallow water. A prominent white ear patch was quickly noted. A few Lesser Scaup females were close and a comparison was made. Ruled out Scoter species because of plumage, head shape, and behavior.

My brother and I were a bit confused to say the least; and until the bird flew showing a reddish tail, only then we were able to determine that it was a Red-tail Hawk. This bird was perched and facing us. Using a zoom telescope We noted a wide black belly band. Face and head were a dark brown. Throat, upper preast and leg feathers were a rufaus.
