Seasonal Summary

Common Loons were apparent on all of the larger lakes. Waterfowl numbers seemed good although many ducks were in inaccessible places. Two Black Terns in Van Buren County were early. 104 species were recorded on 29 April on the IOU field trip to southeast lowa. Cool and damp weather seemed to affect passerine migration in the yard. The first major push of warblers an other neotropical migrants did not occur until 6 May, although an Orange-crowned Warbler was very early. Other earlier than normal arrivals included House Wren and Lark Sparrow. Sparrow numbers were about average in mid-April.
