Gray Partridge Pairs of birds appear to be more numerous than Mar-May in last few years. Several very small flocks (5-15 birds ea) seen in L. Golden Plover 4/24-5/12 Dickinson & Osceola Co's, but numbers below normal. Almost none noted on migration, in spite of "Peeps" what appeared to be prime habitat conditions. Black Terns 5/23/95 Numerous at Christopherson Slough, in NE 50+ Dickinson County. 1 5/10/95 At Kettleson Hogsback WMA, Dickinson Co. Seen in Western Kingbird about 1 of 3 years here: seemed early this year. Very large numbers of ovenbirds noted in Lyon, 5/10-5/18 Ovenbird Dickinson & O'Brien Co's, even in yards around town. Largest numbers I recall seeing on migration. Male near Melvin, Osceola Co. Though habitat is Blue Grobeak 1 5/25/95 minimal, these birds appear to continue increasing in NW Iowa.
