THIS SPRING WAS THE WORST SHORE BIRD MIGRATION AS FAR AS BIRDS WHO USUALLY MIGRATE DURING APRIL AND FIRST WEEKS OF MAY. LESSER YELLOWLEGS AND PECTORALS USUALLY NUMBER IN THE HUNDREDS WHILE THIS YEAR MOSTLY SINGLE DIGIT NUMBERS OF BIRDS WERE SEEN. NUMBERS OF SOME SPECIES DID PICK UP A LITTLE AFTER THE SECOND WEEK OF MAY. UNUSUAL SPECIES, WILLET AND RUDDY TURNSTONE WERE SEEN IN HIGHEST EVER COUNTS WITH BLACK BELLED PLOVER AND RED NECK PHALAROPE ALSO SEEN. SOME THINK THAT BIRDS MIGRATED FURTHER WEST. WELL,
