Temperatures were near normal. Rainfall was above normal. Habitat loss due to Dr. Egli's nearby development was again possible independent variable in decline in numbers of some of my feeder visitors. White-breasted Nuthatches, Northern Cardinals, and Tufted Titmice were the most regular visitors reflecting first definite decline in numbers in other four years of feeding in this spot.
