SPECIES: Red-necked Grebe NUMBER: 2 DAIE: 1 May 1986

LOCATION: Little Wall L.

DETAILS: The birds were 1 1/2 times larger than a nearby American Coot. The back, back of neck, and crown were dark. The throat and cheek were white. Neck and breast were a deep rufous red color. The bill was almost as long as the head, thick, and yellowish in color. The long neck and overall stocky appearance identified the birds as grebes.
